SUMMIT Vision:

To improve the lives of Colorado's rural Hispanic farmworkers and communities by understanding our purpose, and by identifying, convening, and strengthening coalitions. To build on the work done at The Colorado Agriculture and Farm Labor SUMMIT: Collaboration for Collective Impact by moving formally into developing and committing to action steps to better serve these communities.
